## Granite Worktop Information

Granite is a hard, slightly porous stone with various surface finishes. It is extremely durable, heat resistant, easy to care for and will retain its colour and elegance. Because of these qualities it is ideally suited for kitchens and bathrooms.

Granite has a natural make-up and beauty. Therefore variations in veining and colour, as well as natural markings, pits, dull patches and vents are unavoidable, but mean that your project will be unique. All materials supplied are stopped or reinforced where necessary and no claim on this account can be made.

**Because of this we strongly recommend that you arrange to view your slabs before we template as dissatisfaction cannot be accepted as our responsibility.**

## Stone Care

- Clean on a regular basis using a cloth and soapy water or mild detergent.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaning materials e.g. scouring pads.
- Avoid using bleach or other chlorine based cleaners, acids or concentrated disinfectants. If they come into contact with the stone, clean them off quickly.
- Food that is strongly coloured, acidic or oily e.g. red wine, lemon juice and cooking oil can stain the surface. Clean any such spillages as soon as they occur.
- Avoid cutting directly onto the stone surface. Always use a chopping board. This will also stop your knives from blunting.
- If possible, try to put pans on a pan stand.
- Over time, it is normal for the original high sheen to mellow. If a care kit has been provided, use the polishing cream to restore dull patches that could occur from normal wear and tear.

## General Information

Please be aware that due to the nature of stone, joints will be visible and can be felt. For customers having a recessed drainer area please note this is a feature. Due to the way it is manufactured the same degree of polished finish cannot be achieved. This may result in a difference in colour.

We sell up to 200 different products, and maintenance can vary dramatically for each one. We therefore advise every effort is taken by yourselves that products you have selected meet your expectations for the particular environment you wish to use it in.
